Event: Stroller Skating at the Magic Season Ice Arena brought to you by Bank of America

Times: **Special hours for stroller skating only!**
December 1, 8, 15 & January 5: 2pm-3pm (rink opens to all skaters at 3pm)
December 22 & 29: 10am-11am (rink opens to all skaters at 11am)

Parking: Free parking (3 hour limit) available near event site in the southwest corner of Bellevue Downtown Park near NE 1st Street & 100th Avenue NE.

Guests: Stroller skaters are invited to an hour of skating on the only open-air ice rink in the area before the venue opens to the public on Thursdays. Older children are welcome to skate and accompany the stroller-riding younger ones.

Children sizes range from a toddler 9 through 13. Adult sizes range from 1 through 14 (no half sizes).

Public restroom facilities with baby changing stations are available a short walk from the ice arena (a temporary structure built in the pond area at Bellevue Downtown Park).

Fee: Normal admission fee of \$10 (includes skate rental) applies for each skater. Cash & credit cards accepted.

Format: Stroller skating is exclusively held during these special hours on Thursdays during the season. Strollers are not allowed on the ice during regular public hours.

A warming tent is available for break time and includes a concession stand with hot chocolate, coffee and other treats!
